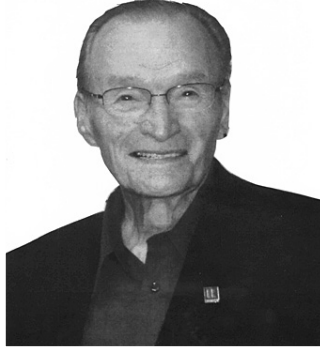


**RUE,
