Grace Allen, aged 93 years, passed away at Watrous District Health Complex on Tuesday, September 6, 2016.

Grace was born November 13, 1922 to Arthur and Eleanor (Nel Wasden) Hill on their farm 7 miles southwest of Renown Sask. Grace was the fourth oldest in a family of five.

Grace moved to the farm that Verdi was renting from a Land Company where Gary was born in 1947 and also a stillborn son.
