Over the last few years, Harold's memory started to slip but he was able to remain in his own home with the wonderful home care staff checking in on him daily. He very recently moved to Central Parkland Lodge in Lanigan and settled in nicely really enjoying the opportunity of being able to visit with the other residents. His time there was short, and after only two weeks into his stay, he passed away peacefully in his sleep.
