Hilda Heinrichs, aged 100 years, passed away peacefully in Luther Care Home, Saskatoon, Sask. on Sunday, July 31, 2016 with family at her side.

Hilda lived most of her life in and near Drake, Sask. When she left school

after Gr. 8 her first job was doing housework during the threshing season at McFarlands in Drake. She married Jake Heinrichs in 1935. They lived in Wilmot area, B.C. for a short time and for many years on a farm in the Grovenland district. They had four daughters - Doris, Gladys, Ella and Bev. In 1952 they took their house with them and moved into the town of Drake. Hilda was a member of the North Star Mennonite Church where she taught Sunday school and was an active member of the Ladies Aid. Her first "real" job was working for four years in the Drake grocery store. After Jake passed away on Feb. 14, 1994, Hilda continued to live in the Drake Manor until she moved to Bethany Manor in Saskatoon in 2008 and to Luther Care Home in 2014.

Hilda is survived by four children: Doris (late John Regier) of Watrous, Gladys (Ken Schmidt) of Courtenay, B.C., Ella (Henry Funk) and Bev (Allan Regehr) both of Saskatoon, 11 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and 5 great-great grandchildren. Also left to mourn is her sister Irene (Jake Wiebe) of Saskatoon.

Celebration of life was held at Mount Royal Mennonite Church, Saskatoon, Sask. on August 5 conducted by Pastor Claire Ewert Fisher.
