Abe passed away at Manitou Lodge of the Watrous District Health Complex on Thursday, January 18, 2024 at the age of 88 years.

Abe was born on the family farm northeast of Watrous on December 12, 1935, son of Jacob and Elizabeth (Kroeker) Schellenberg. Abe was the fifth oldest of 11 siblings and was the last surviving of his brothers. His older sister Katie died just 13 days after Abe's death;

leaving one younger sister Anne as the only survivor of the Schellenberg siblings. Abe worked as a journeyman electrician and a mechanical contractor for most of his life. Abe worked at a nickel mine in northern Manitoba as an electrician. He owned and operated a couple of electrical businesses in Saskatoon, where he specialized in water treatment plants and sewage handling facilities. This took him to many communities all over Saskatchewan. Abe really enjoyed the outdoors, especially hunting and fishing and in later years he developed and operated the Delwood Campground on the northeast end of Manitou Lake just off the sand bar road. He even had a rainbow trout pond at his campground.

At Abe's request, no funeral was held, with interment of his cremains will take place at a later date at the Bethany Cemetery.
